

Hot School Meals at Leigh on Mendip First School



Hot school meals are prepared by Gary Monger and his catering staff at Writhlington School and they are brought to us freshly cooked each day. They cost £2.50 each and are ordered on a weekly basis.

We have a three week rolling menu which caters for all diets including vegetarian and vegan. The catering staff are also very understanding of all special dietary requirements and will happily cater for children with allergies.

Menu letters are sent home with children at the beginning of the week to order hot school meals for the following week. We request that all order forms and payments, where applicable, are handed into the school office by Friday morning of the week in which the menu is sent home. This enables us to collate all information and place the order by the Friday morning deadline. There are menus and order forms on the school website if you need to print an additional copy.

The Universal Infant Free School Meal Scheme provides hot school meals for all children from our Reception year through to, and including, Year two. If your child is not in this age group then meals are charged at £2.50 per day.

When a school trip is planned and your child is entitled to the Universal Infant Free School Meal the kitchen will provide a packed lunch, with a choice of sandwich fillings. The packed lunch will be delivered to the school the day before the trip and kept in the school fridge ready for your child to take with them the next day. If this is an option the list of sandwich fillings will be on the menu sheet for you to make a choice.
